The Organising Committee of the World University Golf Championship 2014 is pleased to provide some useful information for the sporting event to be held on the Severiano Ballesteros course at the Crans-sur-Sierre golf club in Crans-Montana.

Tournament:

Participants:

24 nations are registered for the 15th World University Golf Championship in Crans-Montana, which is a new record. 144 players, 75 men and 69 women, have been selected to participate in the tournament.

General information:

The competition will take place on the completely remodelled Severiano Ballesteros course, which the participants will discover on practice day, Monday 23 June 2014. There will be no opportunity to practice on the course beforehand, since the [Olivier Barras Memorial](#) is being played there from 20 to 22 June 2014. However, the driving range and other training areas are open to participants upon their arrival in Crans-Montana.

Practice:

The official practice day is Monday 23 June 2014. Part of the driving range will be reserved exclusively for the use of the 144 players selected for the tournament. Golf balls will be made available free of charge from 7:00 AM to 3:00 PM.

Golf carts will provide transportation from the clubhouse to the driving range.

Only the 144 players in the tournament will be able to play a practice round on the Severiano Ballesteros course. They choose their departure time by signing up on a start sheet posted at the reception of the Grand Hôtel du Golf & Palace.

Competition:





Tuesday 24 and Wednesday 25 June 2014:

The driving range will be open from 5:45 AM to 5:00 PM. Golf balls are made available free of charge to players in the tournament. Golf carts will provide transportation from the clubhouse to the driving range.

Starts will take place simultaneously from tees 1 and 10 from 7:00 AM to 2:10 PM, by flights of three players.

Thursday 26 and Friday 27 June 2014:

The driving range will be open from 5:45 AM to 5:00 PM. Golf balls are made available free of charge to players in the tournament. Golf carts will provide transportation from the clubhouse to the driving range.

The 144 players will all start from tee 1 from 6:45 AM to 2:35 PM, by flights of three players.

The starting order on Thursday and Friday will be based on the prior standings.

The Organising Committee reserves the right to modify the above schedule if unforeseeable events occur.

Transmission of live results:

The PC Caddie system broadcasts individual scores, live, for each hole.

Real time results are available on mobile devices and on large screens placed at strategic locations, in hotels and the club house.

At the end of the course, a large scoreboard will show the results of each player's round.

Announcement of results:

The results will be announced on Friday 27 June 2014 at the end of the competition, followed by the closing ceremony.

Referees:

7 referees, headed by the chief referee of the Swiss Golf Association, Charles-André Bagnoud, will ensure that the competition is played in accordance with the rules of golf.

Anti-doping control:



Anti-doping controls will be carried out in accordance with the FISU Anti-Doping Regulations (see www.wucgolf2014.com, Competition, FISU, Golf Regulations, FISU Anti-Doping Regulations).
